Polar the white wombat

The extremely rare one-year-old southern hairy nosed wombat was found sick and dehydrated, wandering in a wheat paddock near Ceduna by shearers about five weeks ago.

Wombat Fauna and Rescue farm owner, Val Salmon, is caring for him. She said that in her 40 years of rescuing sick and injured wombats, Polar was only the third white wombat she had cared for.

"He's really really rare. We do get dark ginger ones, but this little one is near on white; he's a little cutey," she said.

"Either the mother abandoned him because of the colouring or something happened to her. If he turns into a naughty boy, which they often do, he will go into a breeding program," she added.

"They are not a pet."

Ms Salmon said the <u>Department of Environment and Heritage</u> gave her special milk for the wombats but she and her husband paid for everything else, including vet fees.
