LMERC is a DE specialised library with a focus on EAL, Languages, Cross Curriculum Priority Areas & Intercultural Capability

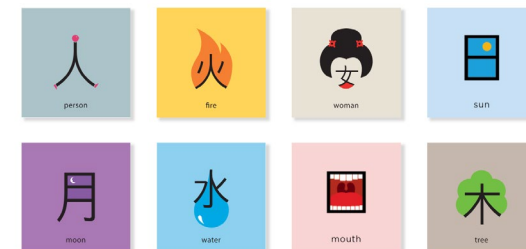
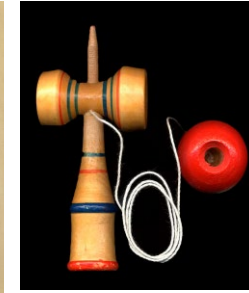
### LMERC provides

- state-wide service
- free membership
- long loans
  - teachers -12 weeks
  - pre-service teachers - 6 weeks (extension available if on placement)
- materials in languages taught in schools and community languages



# LMERC collection overview

- 26,000 items in catalogue
- In over 60 languages
- All formats – books, games, websites, electronic resources, realia, flash cards, songs, articles, posters, puppets, eBooks
- Teacher reference
- Bilingual and monolingual resources
- LearnPath guides (curated resource collections) on topics such as: CLIL, picture books in languages, books celebrating languages, posters and flyers about multilingualism

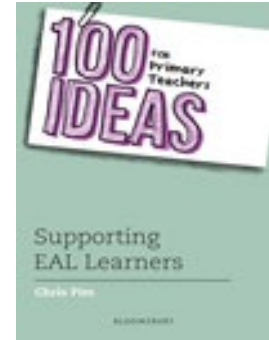

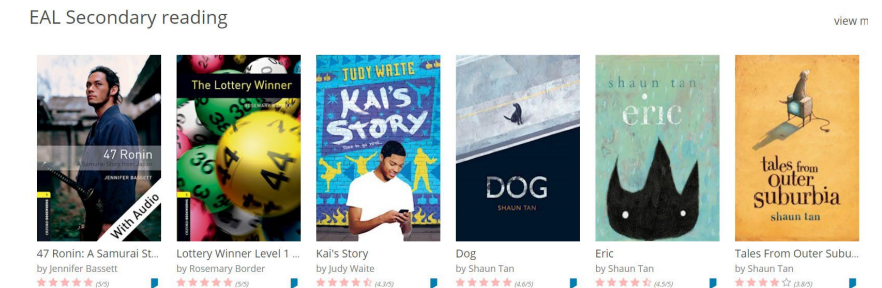


## WHEELERS

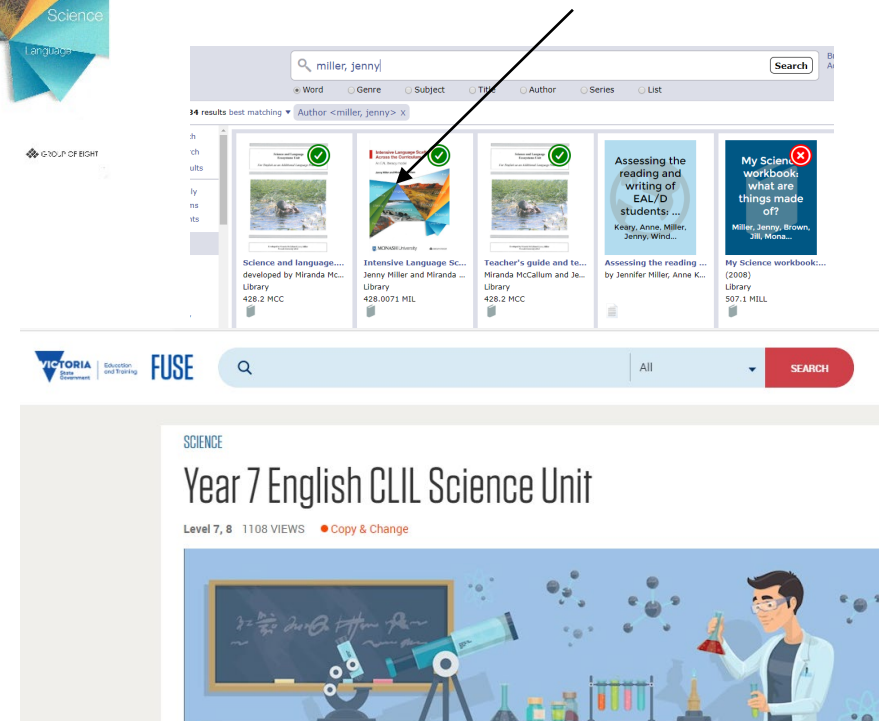

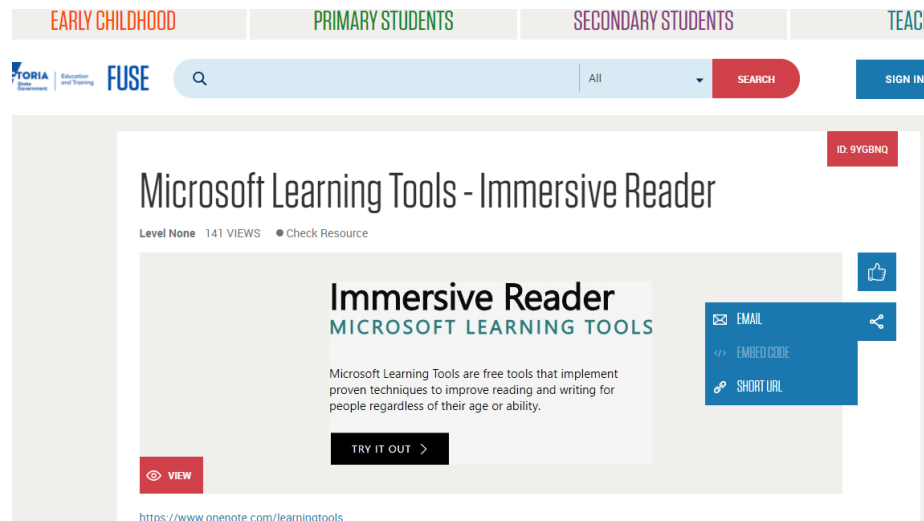
TEAL is an assessment 'toolkit' developed by teachers for teachers working with children who are learning English as an additional language (EAL) in Australia.

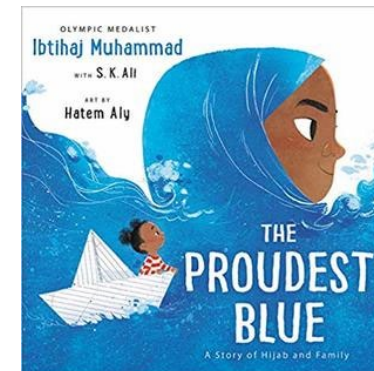
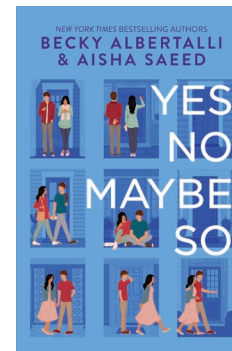
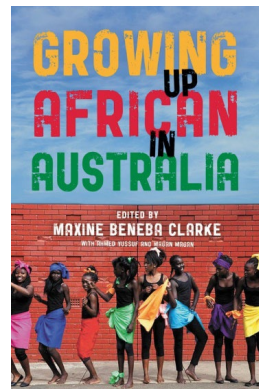
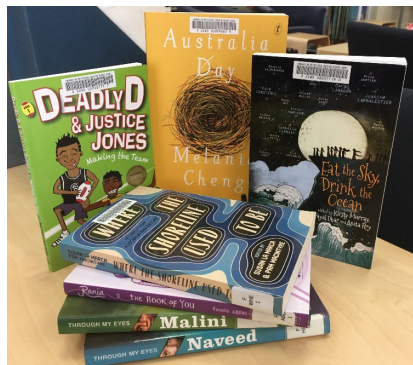


# Culturally diverse and representative texts

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## LMERC Services

- LMERC provides free postage to government schools outside of the metro area (limit of one request per term). School pays return postage or member of school community may return in school holidays.
- Assistance is available to organise courier delivery to all other sectors
- 'Pick and Pack' service – resource requests for pick up or delivery by email or phone - by providing details such as topics, levels, teaching approaches, formats or type – physical or digital - lesson plans, activity, video, games, big books, articles, ebooks etc and when you need the resources by.
- Choose from the catalogue - login with card number (username and password) - drag and drop covers to basket – choose 'more actions' – 'send request'
- Customised presentations in the library or online
- [LMERC eNewsletter](#) (6-8 times per year) - includes DE and other organisation's initiatives for educators, new resources at LMERC & online, journal article alerts, events, professional learning. [Subscribe](#)

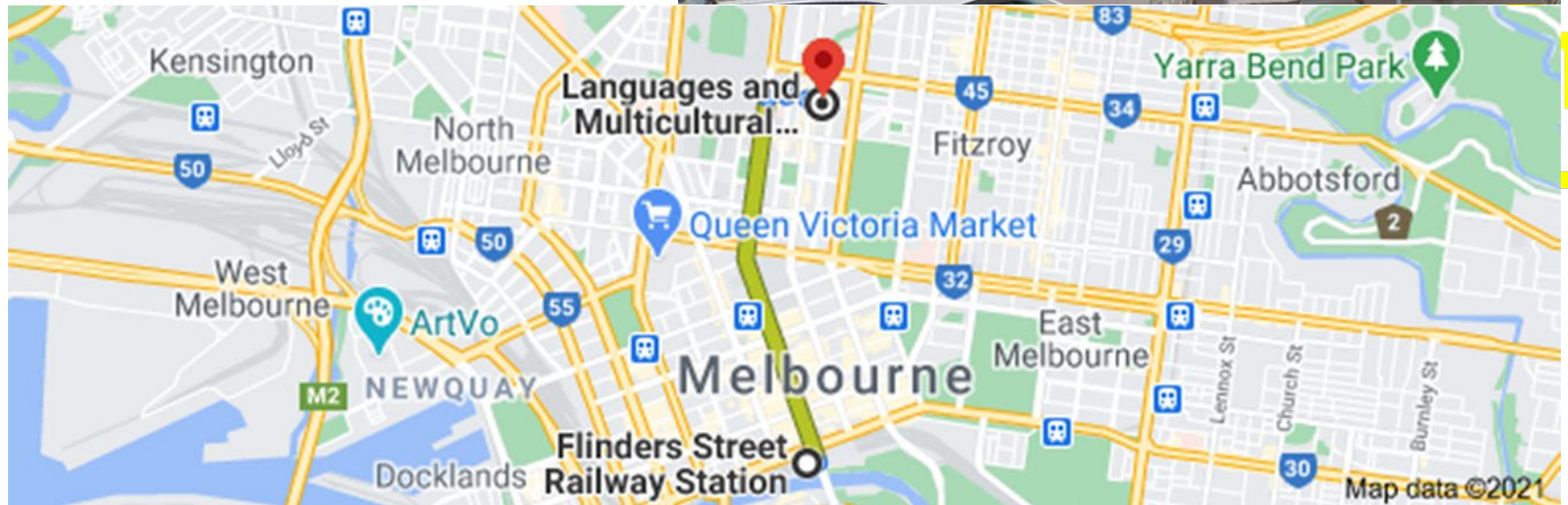
