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My Research and Findings

Research:

- inspired by experiences during remote delivery
- gauged the situation in digital transformation in Victoria and Australia
- followed digital transformation projects in adult education in the USA and Europe

Findings:

- Challenges are universal
- Grassroots creativity
- Complexity of professional learning in education

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Teacher Professional Learning

- teachers should have agency in their learning · they should use their strengths and consider students' needs
- Every educational institution is unique in a number of ways. Student cohorts and their needs may vary between organisations and inside them.
- learning should focus on changing practice (not just gaining information and/or changing beliefs)
- important to extend learning (people do not learn in short intensive sessions)

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SELFIE for TEACHERS WHAT?

SELFIE stands for **S**elf-reflection on **E**ffective Learning by **F**ostering the use of **I**nnovative **E**ducational technologies.
 It is a free **online tool**.

SELFIE for TEACHERS is based on The **European Framework for the Digital Competence of Educators (DigCompEdu)**.

In 2020 the Australian Digital Transformation Expert Panel recommended to adopt (and adapt if necessary) the framework.

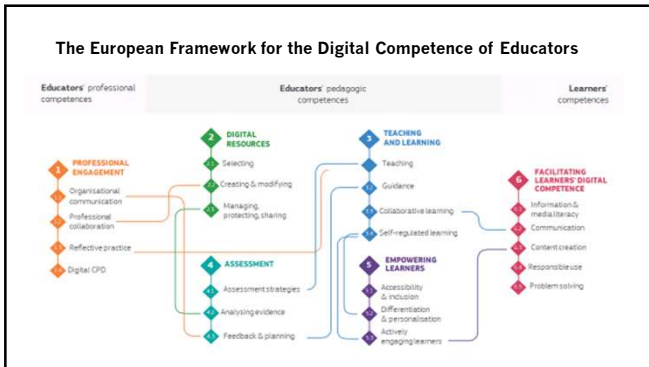


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The European Framework for the Digital Competence of Educators



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SELFIE for TEACHERS HOW?

1. Answer a series of reflective questions, addressing 6 areas that include between 3 and 9 competencies (items), totally 32.
2. Receive an automated report showing your current capabilities in each area, along with suggestions on how to improve.
3. Access the available certification and apply for a digital badge.
