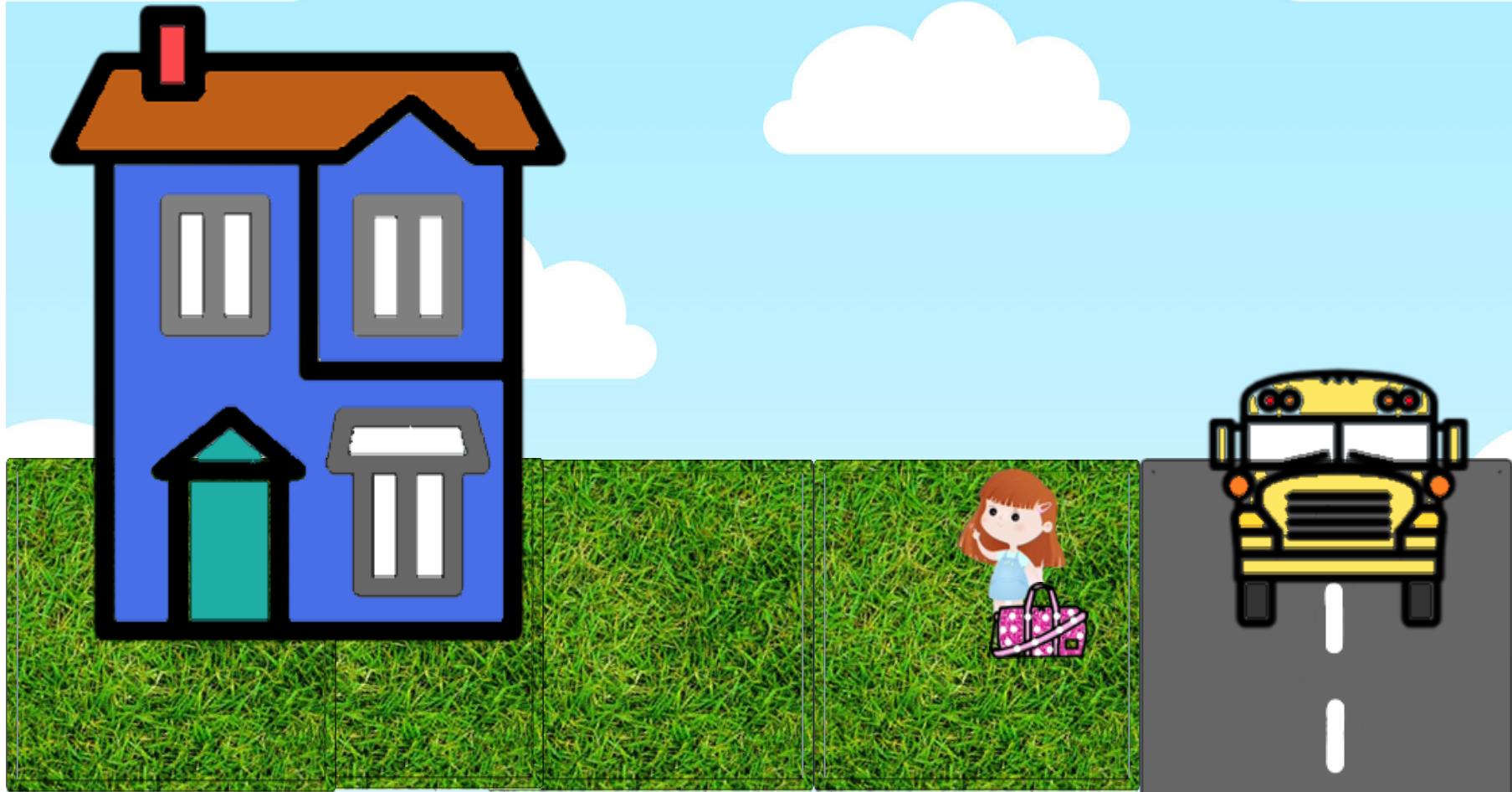
In Trixie's messy room, we find her quickly packing her bags. She is leaving for her school camp in a few minutes.

“All children go to school to learn, maybe she is at school” said Furfus confidently.

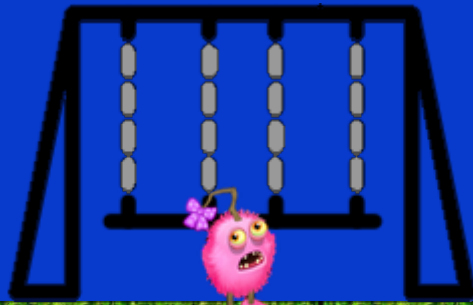
So the group of monsters begin their journey to Trixie’s school.

"Where else could she have gone?" said Furfus.

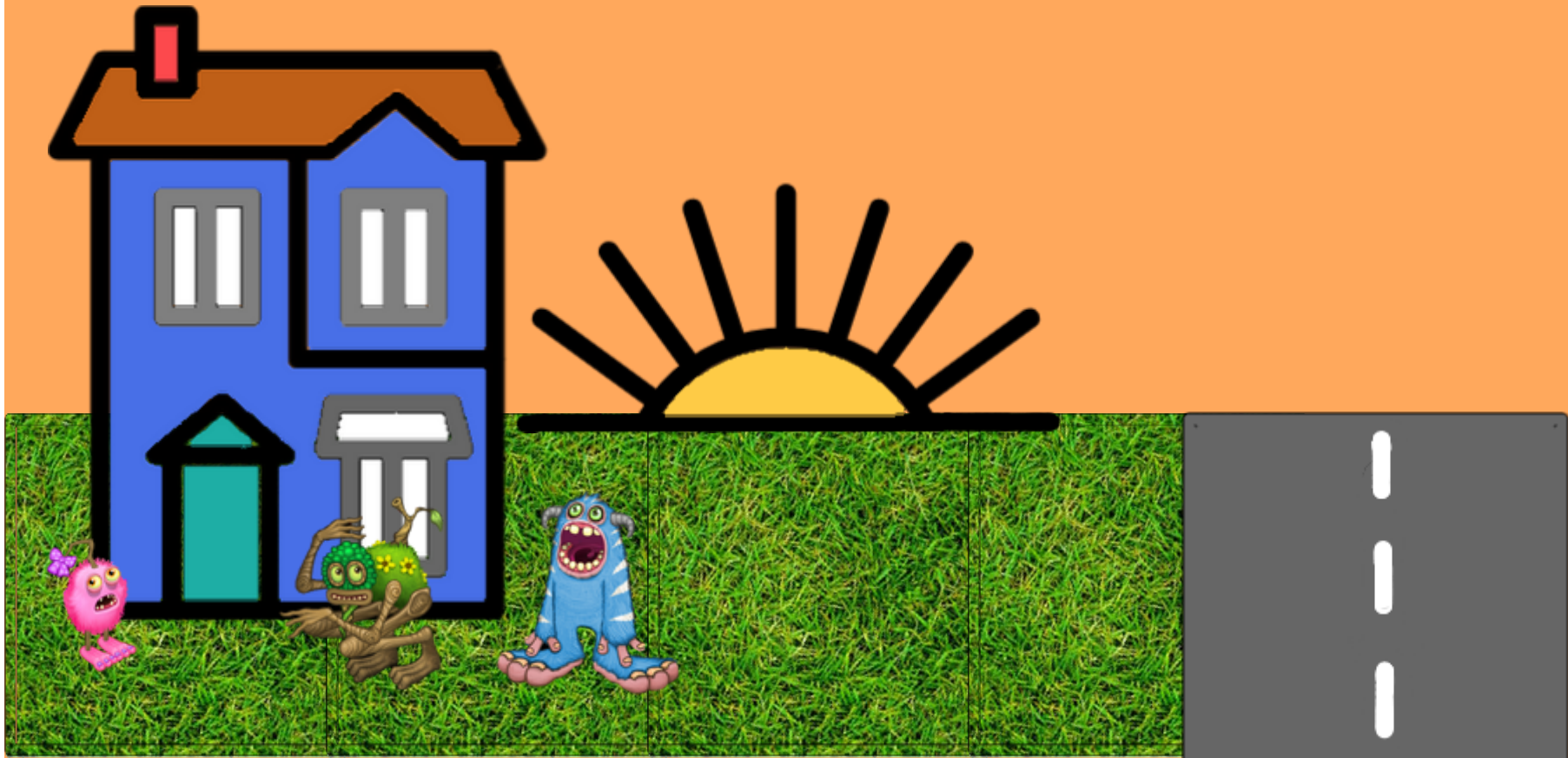
"We can't look any further, the sun is about to rise" said Farkle.

They quietly go back through the front door, once again being careful to not disturb Mum and Dad and head to Trixie's room.



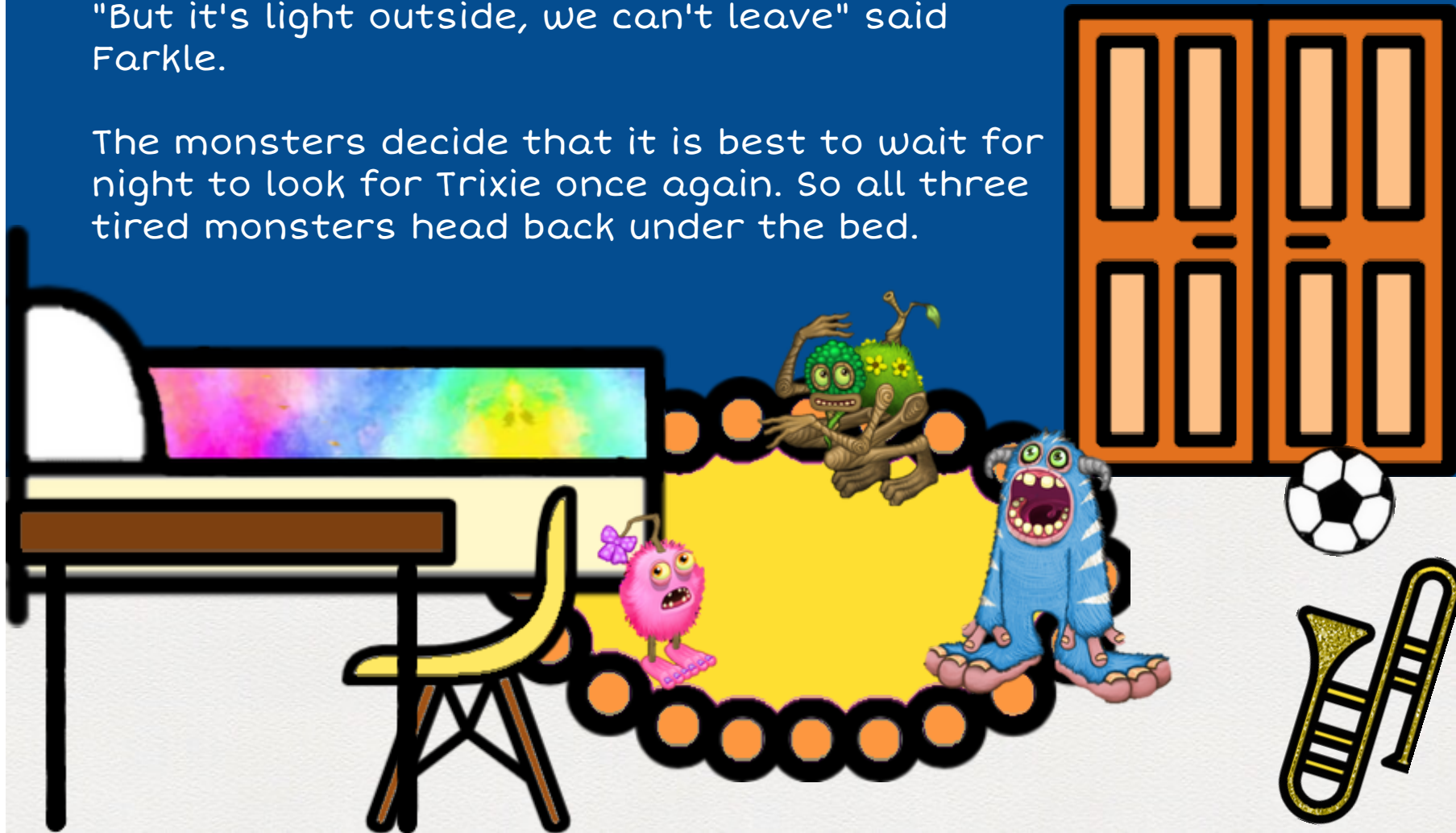
"Without Trixie here, we have no one to scare"

"We need our girl back!" said Fizzmo.

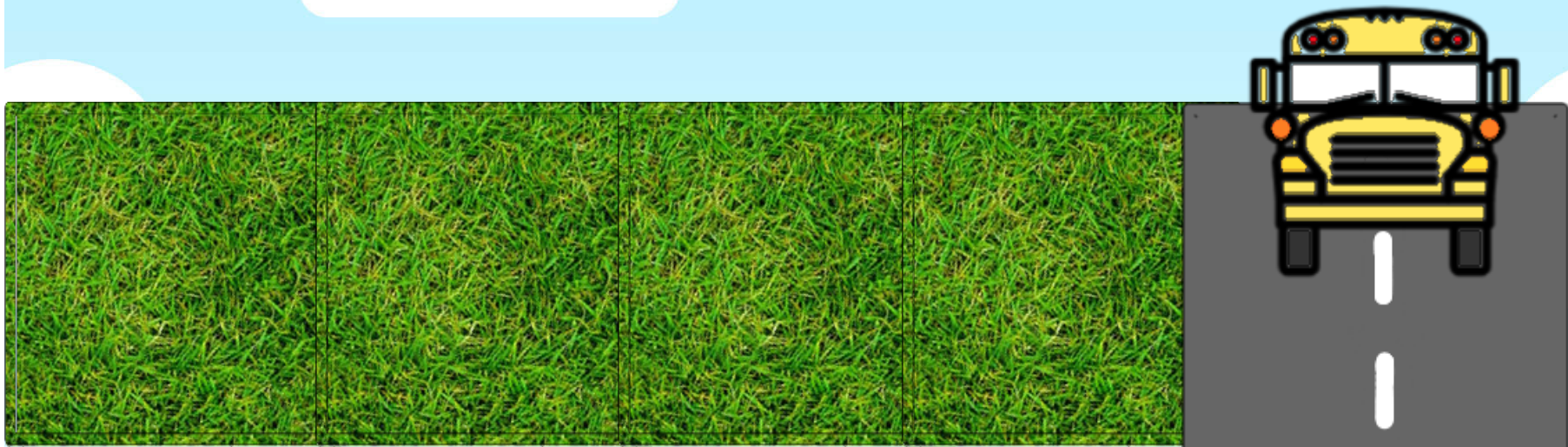
"But it's light outside, we can't leave" said
